FAST FACTS

- **The Doc Is In: Derek Ryan** has registered a point in six straight games (3/26-4/5: 2g, 6a), establishing a new career-long point streak. Ryan has earned career highs in points (38), assists (23) and goals (15) this season.
- **Dahly Lama: Klas Dahlbeck** scored his first goal of the season on Thursday against Philadelphia. Dahlbeck has recorded a point in three straight games (3/31-4/5), matching his career-long point streak (10/22/15-10/26/15: 2g, 1a).

The Hurricanes have tallied 30-or-more shots in 24 of their last 32 games (1/30-4/5) and are tied for first in the League in 30-shot games (62) this season. This is the first time the team has tallied 60-or-more 30-shot games in franchise history. Carolina has also registered 40-or-more shots on goal 11 times this season. The Canes are tied for 13th in the League in 40-shot games this season. In addition, the Canes are ranked fourth in the NHL in shots per game (33.8) this season and are ranked first in fewest shots against per game (28.8). The Hurricanes are the only team in the League to place in the top-5 in both shots for and shots against.

A+ FOR AHO

Sebastian Aho scored his 29th goal of the season on Thursday at Philadelphia. Aho (29) is aiming to reach the 30-goal mark for the first time in his career and become the second Finnish-born player to hit the 30-goal plateau this season (Patrik Laine: 44). Aho has registered 18 points in his last 19 games (2/27-4/5: 8g, 10a) and leads the team with career-highs in points (65), goals (29) and power-play goals (8). In March, Aho earned a point in a career-high nine consecutive games (3/8-3/26: 4g, 8a) and tallied an assist in a career-long seven consecutive games (3/12-3/24: 2g, 8a). Aho's career-long point streak is the fourth-longest point streak among the 2015 NHL Draft class (Connor McDavid: 15; Jack Eichel: 11; Mitchell Marner: 11). In addition, Aho has earned the second-most points (114) by a Carolina player in their first two NHL campaigns (Eric Staal: 131).

TURBO TIME

Teuvo Teravainen hit the 40-assist mark for the first time in his career on Thursday against the Flyers. Teravainen is the first Carolina player to record 40-or-more assists in a season since Eric Staal (40) did so in 2013-14. Teravainen has recorded career highs in points (63), assists (40), goals (23) and power-play points (20) this season. He is ranked first on the team in assists (40) and has tallied 18 points in his last 22 games (2/18-4/5: 10g, 8a). The Helsinki, Finland native established a career-long seven-game point streak from March 8-March 22 (4g, 5a). Since he joined the team last season, Teravainen is ranked first in assists (67) and third in points (105) and goals (38). In addition, Teravainen earned a multi-assist game (0g, 2a) in Carolina's previous meeting with Tampa Bay (1/9).

STAAL IN

Jordan Staal is ranked first among all League skaters in faceoff win percentage since March 1 (59.1%, min. 300 faceoffs) and is ranked fourth in the NHL in faceoff win percentage this season (56.4%, min. 1,200 faceoffs). Staal has taken over 1,000 faceoffs in each of his last three seasons and has ranked in the top-5 in faceoff win percentage in each of those campaigns (2016-17: 3rd – 59.1%; 2015-16: 3rd – 57.8%, min. 1,000 faceoffs). In addition, Staal leads all team forwards in time on ice per game (19:14) and paces all Canes skaters in hits (181) in 2017-18.

SLAVIN AWAY

Jacob Slavin has recorded nine points in his last 10 games (3/17-4/5: 2g, 7a). Since March 17, he is tied for second among all League skaters in plus/minus rating (+10) and is tied for eighth in points (9) among all NHL blueliners. Slavin paces the Canes in blocked shots (154) and time on ice per game (22:35) this season. He is ranked second on the team in takeaways (76) in 2017-18 and his 76 takeaways are ranked first among all NHL defensemen this season. Since he entered the NHL in the 2015-16 campaign, Slavin is ranked first among all League blueliners with 213 takeaways.

Tampa Bay Lightning: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Jon Cooper

Cooper was named Tampa Bay's eighth head coach on March 26, 2013.

Cooper, 50, begins his sixth season as Lightning head coach and has amassed a 189-120-35 record. Cooper's .599 win percentage is the highest in franchise history. He earned NHL victory No. 100 on April 11, 2015, making him the fifth-fastest coach among those who debuted in the NHL since 2000 to reach the mark. He led the Bolts to the Stanley Cup Playoffs in each of his first three full seasons as head coach, including back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals (2015, 2016) and a Stanley Cup Final (2015). He was a finalist for the Jack Adams Award in 2014, given annually to the NHL's top coach. Cooper joined the Lightning after spending the previous three seasons behind the bench of Tampa Bay's top minor league affiliates, the Norfolk Admirals (2010-12) and the Syracuse Crunch (2012-13), compiling a 133-62-26 (.661) record in 221 AHL games. Cooper's NHL head coaching debut came with the Lightning on March 29, 2013.
