Head Coach: Jon Cooper

Cooper was named Tampa Bay's 8th head coach on 3/26/13.

Cooper, 51, begins his 7th season as Lightning head coach and has amassed a 242-143-40 record. Cooper's .616 win percentage is the highest in franchise history. He earned NHL victory No. 100 on 4/11/15, making him the fifth-fastest coach among those who debuted in the NHL since 2000 to reach the mark. He led the Bolts to the Stanley Cup Playoffs in each of his first three full seasons and four of his five full seasons as head coach, including three Eastern Conference Finals appearances in the last four seasons (2015, 2016 and 2018) and a Stanley Cup Final (2015). He was a finalist for the Jack Adams Award in 2014. Cooper joined the Lightning after spending the previous 3 seasons behind the bench of Tampa Bay's top minor league affiliates, the Norfolk Admirals (2010-12) and Syracuse Crunch (2012-13), compiling a 133-62-26 (.661) record in 221 AHL games. Cooper's NHL head coaching debut came with the Lightning on 3/29/13.

HURRICANES vs. LIGHTNING SERIES NOTES

-- The Hurricanes face the Lightning in the first of three meetings between the teams in the 2018-19 season. The two teams will face each other again at Amalie Arena on 1/10 and at PNC Arena on 3/21.

-- Carolina and Tampa Bay have met 121 times in their histories, with the Hurricanes holding a 52-49-10-10 overall record, including a 20-29-3-7 road record.

-- The Lightning won the season series 2-0-1 in 2017-18, winning 5-1 at PNC Arena (10/24) and 5-4 at Amalie Arena (1/9). The Hurricanes earned a 3-2 overtime win over Tampa Bay on 4/7 in Raleigh.

-- Lightning Assistant GM/Director of Player Personnel Pat Verbeek played 433 games for the Hartford Whalers from 1989-95. Verbeek ranks third in franchise history in career penalty minutes (1,144) and power play goals (73), sixth in points (403), and eighth in goals (192) and assists (211).

-- Lightning Assistant Coach Todd Richards played for the Whalers from 1991-92, appearing in eight regular season games with four assists and 11 playoff games with three assists.

-- **Justin Williams** has recorded 36 points (17g, 19a) in 50 career games against the Lightning.

OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT

The Hurricanes' 4-1-1 start is tied for the second-best start through six games in franchise history, and it marks the first time since 2008-09 that Carolina has earned nine points through six games. The team's 23 goals are tied for the fifth-most through six games in franchise history.

SEA BASS NAMED THIRD STAR OF THE WEEK

Sebastian Aho, who ranks tied for third in the NHL in points (4g, 7a), was named the NHL's Third Star of the Week on Monday after posting seven points (3g, 4a) in three games during the week ending Oct. 14. Aho has earned at least one point in every game so far this season, and he is the sixth player in franchise history to open the regular season with a six-game point streak. He has four goals so far this season after being held without an October goal in each of his first two NHL seasons. Aho, who scored 29 goals last season, scored his first goal of 2017-18 in game 16, and scored 24 goals in 2016-17 after scoring his first goal of the season in game 14.

CLIMBING THE RANKS

Justin Faulk posted two assists at MIN (10/13), tying Glen Wesley for the second-most career points by a defenseman in franchise history. Faulk has registered 227 points with the Hurricanes and ranks first among defensemen in career goals (74). Dave Babych is the franchise leader for career points by a defenseman, recording 240 points (44g, 196a) in 349 games with the Whalers from 1985-91.

SHOOTING RANGE

The Hurricanes lead the NHL in shots per game (42.3), and they are outshooting their opponents by a league-high margin of 17.3 shots per game. Carolina has outshot their opponents in 17-of-18 regulation periods this season. **Dougie Hamilton** and **Jordan Staal** lead the Hurricanes in shots with 22 each.

FOURTH LINE FIRES AWAY

The line combination of **Jordan Martinook** (5), **Lucas Wallmark** (3) and **Andrei Svechnikov** (7) racked up a total of 15 shots on goal at WPG (10/14).

BIG MAC

Curtis McElhinney is the first goaltender to win his first three starts with the Hurricanes since Justin Peters in 2010. Jeff Reese is the only goaltender in franchise history to win his first four starts with the team, accomplishing the feat in 1993.

HEAVY HITTERS

The Hurricanes rank second in the NHL in hits this season (142) following Sunday's game. **Jordan Staal** (22) leads the team and is second in the NHL in the category. In 2017-18, Carolina ranked 28th in the NHL in hits.

CENTURY MARK

Teuvo Teravainen registered a pair of assists at MIN (10/13), giving him 100 assists in his NHL career. Teravainen has recorded 73 assists in 169 games with the Hurricanes (0.43 per game), after posting 27 assists in 115 games with the Blackhawks (0.23 per game).

QUICK ON THE DRAW

Following Sunday's game, **Jordan Staal** ranks first in the NHL in faceoff wins (84) and has won 56.0% of his draws this season. Staal finished sixth in faceoff win percentage in the NHL last season (56.6%).

GIMME THAT

Carolina leads the league in takeaways (61) so far this season, after leading the NHL in the category last season with 887. **Sebastian Aho** (9) leads the Hurricanes and ranks tied for third in the NHL in the category.

MEET THE NEW BOSS

Rod Brind'Amour was named the 14th head coach in franchise history and fifth since relocation on May 8, 2018. He spent the previous seven seasons as an assistant coach with the team after spending two seasons in a player development role from 2010-12. Brind'Amour played 21 NHL seasons, including 10 with Carolina, where he is third in franchise history in assists (299), fourth in points

(473), fifth in in games played (694) and 10th in goals (174). He was the captain of the Hurricanes during their Stanley Cup-winning 2005-06 season, and he has appeared in more playoff games (72) than any other player in franchise history. With Carolina's 5-4 OT win at MIN (10/13), Brind'Amour became the first head coach in franchise history to earn points in each of his first five games behind the bench (4-0-1).

Carolina Hurricanes: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Rod Brind'Amour

Rod Brind'Amour was named the 14th head coach in franchise history (fifth since relocation) on May 8th, 2018. He spent the last seven seasons as an assistant coach after serving the team in player development from 2010-12. Brind'Amour played 1,484 career NHL games in 21 seasons with STL, PHI and CAR, posting 1,184 points (452g, 732a) and captaining the Hurricanes to the Stanley Cup in 2006. He ranks third in franchise history in career assists (299), fourth in points (473), fifth in games played (694) and tenth in goals (174).

Drafted by STL ninth overall in the 1988 NHL Draft, Brind'Amour was acquired by the Hurricanes on Jan. 23, 2000 from PHI along with Jean-Marc Pelletier and a second-round pick in the 2000 NHL Draft (Agris Saviels) in exchange for Keith Primeau and a fifth-round pick in the 2000 NHL Draft (Kristofer Ottosson).

Brind'Amour made his coaching debut in a 2-1 OT loss vs. NYI on 10/4, and earned his first win in a 3-1 victory at CBJ on 10/5.
