## CIRCLE THE WAGONS

The Hurricanes recorded their seventh straight win over the Sabres, which is their longest active winning streak over any opponent. This ties their longest winning streak against Buffalo in franchise history, as Hartford won seven straight matchups in the series from 2/19/86-11/26/86.

## FER SURE

**Micheal Ferland** set a new career high with three points tonight (1g, 2a), marking his third multi-point game of the season and the 14th multi-point game of his career. It is also the second multi-assist game of his career and the first since 3/28/16 at ARI, while playing for CGY.

## WE'RE GOING STREAKING

**Justin Williams** scored a goal tonight. He has recorded a point in six straight games (1/3-1/11: 5g, 1a) and scored a goal in four straight games (1/6-1/11: 4g). **Trevor van Riemsdyk** assisted on Williams' goal and has posted an assist in three consecutive games (1/8-1/11: 3a).

## FINN IT TO WIN IT

**Sebastian Aho** (2g) and **Teuvo Teravainen** (2a) each registered multi-point games tonight. Aho has recorded 11 multi-point games this season and 36 in his career, while Teravainen has recorded 10 multi-point games this season and 36 in his career. The two players have now notched a point on the same goal 28 times this season, and either Aho or Teravainen has recorded a point on 55 of Carolina's 116 goals this season (47.4%).

## SEABASS STEPS UP

**Sebastian Aho** scored two goals tonight to bring his team-leading point total to 47 (18g, 29a) through 44 games. Last season, when Aho set a career high with 65 points (29g, 36a), he recorded his 47th point in his 57th game.

## HEAVY HITTERS

Carolina outhit Buffalo 38-18 tonight. **Andrei Svechnikov**, **Jordan Martinook** and **Warren Foegele** led the Hurricanes with five hits each, while 14 different players registered a hit for Carolina.

## HANGING ON

With tonight's win, the Hurricanes improved to 15-4-2 when scoring first and 16-1-2 when leading after two periods.

## SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 0-for-2 on the power play tonight and is now 24-for-148 (16.2%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes went 3-for-4 on the penalty kill and are now 112-for-140 (80.0%) on the kill this season.
- Buffalo went 1-for-4 on the power play tonight and is now 25-for-134 (18.7%) on the man-advantage this season. The Sabres went 2-for-2 on the penalty kill and are now 108-for-128 (84.4%) on the kill this season.
