-- Sebastian Aho opened the scoring for the Hurricanes, marking his first game-opening goal of the season. He has now scored five goals in his last two games and posted 12 points (6g, 6a) in his last seven games.

-- Saku Maenalanen scored a goal today, giving him two goals in his last four games.

-- Jaccob Slavin recorded an assist today, and he has tallied six points (2g, 4a) in his last eight games.

SOMETHING'S FISHY

Sebastian Aho posted four points today (3g, 1a), and he has now registered 51 points (21g, 30a) through 45 games. Last season, when he recorded a career-high 65 points (29g, 36a), he posted his 51st point in his 62nd game. He is the first Hurricanes player to reach 20 goals in 45 team games since Jeff Skinner in 2013-14. By scoring his 20th goal, he became the fourth player in franchise history to make their NHL debut with the team and score 20 goals in each of their first three seasons, joining Ron Francis, Sylvain Turgeon and Kevin Dineen.

FREE WILLY

Justin Williams has scored a goal today for the fifth consecutive game, tying the longest goal-scoring streak of his career (3/28/13-4/4/13: 6g). He has now recorded a point in seven straight games (1/3-1/13: 6g, 1a), marking his longest point streak since a seven-game streak from 3/28/13-4/7/13 (6g, 2a). He is just the sixth player in NHL history to record a goal streak of at least five games after turning age 37.

FINN IT TO WIN IT

Sebastian Aho (3g, 1a) and **Teuvo Teravainen** (2a) each registered multi-point games today. Aho recorded his second career hat trick, previously achieving the feat on 1/31/17 in a 5-1 win vs. PHI, and he also posted his fourth four-point game of the season. Teravainen notched two assists for the second straight game, marking his ninth multi-assist game of the season and 20th of his career.

POWERING UP

Sebastian Aho tallied a point on both of Carolina's power play goals today (1g, 1a), and he has now registered a point on 15 of the Hurricanes' 26 power play goals this season (57.7%).

FAULK APPROACHES HISTORY

Justin Faulk posted an assist today and has now recorded 239 career points (77g, 162a). He is now one point shy of tying Dave Babych (1985-91) for the most points by a defenseman in franchise history.

HANGING ON

With today's win, Carolina improved to 16-4-2 when scoring first, 12-1-2 when leading after the first period, and 17-1-2 when leading after two periods.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 2-for-5 on the power play today and is now 26-for-153 (17.0%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes went 5-for-5 on the penalty kill and are now 117-for-145 (80.7%) on the kill this season.
- Nashville went 0-for-5 on the power play today and is now 23-for-157 (14.6%) on the man-advantage this season. The Predators went 3-for-5 on the penalty kill and are now 113-for-142 (79.6%) on the kill this season.
