- Martin Necas registered two points (1g, 1a) tonight for his third multi-point game of the season and his career.
- Nino Niederreiter tallied two points (1g, 1a) tonight for his seventh multi-point game of the season and the 53rd of his career.
- Brett Pesce posted two assists tonight for his second multi-point game of the season and the 11th of his career.
- Haydn Fleury recorded an assist tonight and has now posted three points in his last four games (2/6-2/14: 1g, 2a).
- Teuvo Teravainen tallied an assist tonight and has now registered 14 points in his last 13 games (1/11-2/14: 4g, 10a).
- Andrei Svechnikov scored a goal tonight and has now recorded 11 points in his last nine games (1/19-2/14: 5g, 6a).

SOMETHING'S FISHY

Sebastian Aho tallied an assist tonight to extend his point streak to eight games (1/21-2/14: 7g, 5a), marking his longest point streak of the season and the third-longest of his career. He is currently on his longest point streak since opening last season with a 12-game point/assist streak from 10/4/18-10/30/18 (4g, 13a).

YEAH SVECH

Andrei Svechnikov scored a goal tonight to extend his point streak to six games (2/2-2/14: 3g, 5a). This marks the second-longest point streak of his career, trailing only his nine-game point streak earlier this season from 11/9-11/27 (5g, 8a). Svechnikov has registered 90 points (42g, 48a) in 139 career NHL games and has posted more career goals and points than any other player selected in the 2018 NHL Draft.

TURBO CHARGED

Teuvo Teravainen recorded his team-leading 43rd assist and 55th point in his 57th game of the season tonight. Last season, when he set career highs in assists (55) and points (76), he earned his 43rd assist in his 64th game and his 55th point in his 62nd game.

THE FINNISH CONNECTION

Sebastian Aho and **Teuvo Teravainen** each posted an assist on Carolina's third goal tonight, marking the 27th time this season the two players recorded a point on the same goal. Either Aho or Teravainen has recorded a point on 81 of the Hurricanes' 181 goals in 2019-20 (44.8%). Teravainen and Aho rank tied for first and tied for third in the NHL, respectively, in points by a Finnish-born player this season.

CZECHING IN

Martin Necas posted two points (1g, 1a) tonight to reach 31 points (15g, 16a) through 53 games played this season. Among all NHL rookies, Necas ranks fourth in goals, seventh in assists and sixth in points.

CAREER YEAR

Warren Foegele scored his 11th goal in his 57th game of the season tonight, surpassing the 10 goals he scored in 77 games during his rookie season in 2018-19. He has also established new career highs in assists (15) and points (26) in 2019-20.

FULL HOUSE

Tonight's attendance was a sellout figure of 18,680, marking Carolina's ninth sellout of the season. The Hurricanes are averaging 16,553 fans per game through 29 games at PNC Arena in 2019-20, for an increase of 18.7% over their average through 29 home games last season (13,951).

BACK IN BLACK

Carolina wore their black alternate uniforms for the 11th of 15 times in 2019-20, and they now own a 7-3-1 record so far this season in those games. Since debuting their current third jerseys in the 2018-19 season, the Hurricanes have posted a 23-7-3 record (including regular season and playoffs) when wearing their black uniforms.

VALENTINE'S DAY

The Hurricanes played on Valentine's Day for the 18th time in franchise history and the first time since 2015, a 6-3 loss at MIN. In franchise history, Carolina now owns a 7-10-1-0 record all-time on Valentine's Day, including a 5-4-0-0 record since relocation and a 4-2-0-0 record at PNC Arena.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 0-for-2 on the power play tonight and is now 37-for-171 (21.6%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes went 4-for-4 on the penalty kill and are now 167-for-202 (82.7%) on the kill this season.
- New Jersey went 0-for-4 on the power play tonight and is now 32-for-200 (16.0%) on the man-advantage this season. The Devils went 2-for-2 on the penalty kill and are now 150-for-186 (80.6%) on the kill this season.
