300 FOR TVR

Trevor van Riemsdyk played his 300th career NHL game tonight. He has tallied 29 points (5g, 24a) in 142 games with Carolina after posting 31 points (8g, 23a) in 158 games with CHI from 2014-17.

KEGG STAND

Greg McKegg scored a goal tonight, increasing his career highs set this season in goals (6) and points (11). McKegg has tallied 0.41 points per game this season after averaging 0.14 points per game in 91 career games prior to this season (7g, 6a).

BACK IN BLACK

The Hurricanes wore their black third jerseys tonight for the 14th of 15 times this season. Carolina debuted the jerseys in an 8-5 win vs. NYR (10/7), and they are now 10-2-2 this season when wearing their new alternate uniforms.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK

Carolina opened their 14th of 17 sets of back-to-back games tonight. The Hurricanes are now 5-6-3 in the first game and 9-3-1 in the second game of back-to-backs.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 0-for-3 on the power play today and is now 37-for-218 (17.0%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes went 1-for-2 on the penalty kill and are now 166-for-204 (81.4%) on the kill this season.
- Winnipeg went 1-for-2 on the power play today and is now 54-for-210 (25.7%) on the man-advantage this season. The Jets went 3-for-3 on the penalty kill and are now 165-for-210 (78.6%) on the kill this season.
