CZECH IT OUT

Petr Mrazek made 18 saves tonight to earn his fourth career playoff shutout and his fifth career playoff win. He is the sixth different goaltender in franchise history to record a postseason shutout and the first since Cam Ward posted a 36-save shutout at BOS on 5/3/09.

DOUG DYNASTY

Dougie Hamilton scored two goals tonight, becoming just the third defenseman in franchise history to score two goals in a playoff game. The only other blueliners to accomplish the feat were Dave Babych vs. MTL on 4/10/88 and Sean Hill at MTL on 5/13/02.

THAT'S A FIRST

Warren Foegele tallied three points tonight (2g, 1a), including his first career playoff goal. **Brock McGinn** recorded two points (1g, 1a), which marked his first career playoff goal and assist. **Jordan Martinook** posted an assist for his first career playoff point, and **Sebastian Aho** registered his first career playoff assist tonight.

DYNAMIC DUO

Sebastian Aho and **Teuvo Teravainen** both assisted on Carolina's second goal tonight. The two players both recorded a point on the same goal 43 times during the regular season, and either Aho or Teravainen tallied a point on 116 of Carolina's 243 goals in 2018-19 (47.7%).

PLAYOFF HOCKEY RETURNS TO PNC ARENA

The Hurricanes hosted a playoff game at PNC Arena for the 37th time and own a 21-15 playoff record in the building. **Justin Williams** has recorded 13 points (5g, 8a) in 14 career playoff games at PNC Arena, which is tied for the sixth-most in the building's postseason history. The Hurricanes last hosted a playoff game on 5/26/09, a 4-1 loss vs. PIT in Game 4 of the Eastern Conference Final. **Jordan Staal** played 19:33 in that game for PIT, while **Rod Brind'Amour** played 11:36 for Carolina.

IT'S BEEN AWHILE

Dougie Hamilton's goal tonight marked his first playoff goal since scoring for BOS vs. MTL on 5/3/14. **Teuvo Teravainen** posted an assist tonight for his first playoff point since recording an assist for CHI at STL on 4/21/16. The last Hurricanes' playoff goal at PNC Arena prior to tonight's game was scored by Eric Staal at 1:36 of the first period vs. PIT on 5/26/09, and the last Carolina player before **Warren Foegele** to score two goals in a home playoff game was also Eric Staal, who scored a pair of goals vs. BOS on 5/8/09.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 2-for-5 on the power play tonight and is now 3-for-13 (23.1%) on the man-advantage this postseason. The Hurricanes went 4-for-4 on the penalty kill and are now 10-for-12 (83.3%) on the kill this postseason.
- Washington went 0-for-4 on the power play tonight and is now 2-for-12 (16.7%) on the man-advantage this postseason. The Capitals went 3-for-5 on the penalty kill and are now 10-for-13 (76.9%) on the kill this postseason.
