THREE FOR THREE

Erik Haula scored a power-play goal tonight and has now tallied a goal in each of his first three games with the Hurricanes. He is the sixth player to score in each of the team's first three games in franchise history, and the first player to accomplish the feat in his first year with the club.

COMEBACK CANES

Carolina has recorded overtime/shootout wins in all three games to start the season after trailing entering the third period in each game. The Hurricanes are now 3-0-0 when trailing after two periods this season after posting a 3-20-3 record when trailing after two periods in 2018-19. Carolina is the 13th team in NHL history to erase a deficit to win their first three games of a season.

SHOOT YOUR SHOT

The Hurricanes outshot the Lightning 44-13 tonight, including 17-0 in the second period. The last time Carolina held an opponent without a shot in a period was in the third period of a 3-1 loss at COL on 2/3/04. **Dougie Hamilton** has tallied two shots tonight to extend his streak to 250 consecutive games with at least one shot on goal. Hamilton was last held without a shot on 4/5/16 vs. LAK while playing for CGY.

POWERING UP

Carolina has scored a power-play goal in all three games this season, including two tonight, and **Teuvo Teravainen** has registered an assist on all four power-play goals.

PESCATARIAN

Brett Pesce scored his first goal of the season tonight and has now registered two points (1g, 1a) through three games this season. Pesce registered career highs in goals (7), assists (22) and points (29) while playing in 73 games during the 2018-19 season.

RETURN OF THE MAC

Curtis McElhinney faced the Hurricanes for the first time since signing with the Lightning in free agency this summer. Last season, McElhinney posted a 20-11-2 record, 2.58 goals-against average, .912 save percentage and two shutouts for Carolina. During the Hurricanes' run to the Eastern Conference Final in the 2019 postseason, he registered a 3-2 record, 2.01 goals-against average and .930 save percentage.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 2-for-5 on the power play tonight and is now 4-for-12 (33.3%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes went 3-for-4 on the penalty kill and are now 11-for-13 (84.6%) on the kill this season.
- Tampa Bay went 1-for-4 on the power play tonight and is now 2-for-9 (22.2%) on the man-advantage this season. The Lightning went 3-for-5 on the penalty kill and are now 8-for-12 (66.7%) on the kill this season.
