CENTURY MARK

Jacob Slavin posted three assists tonight to reach 100 career NHL/Hurricanes assists. He is the 11th defenseman in franchise history, and fifth since relocation, to reach 100 career Hurricanes assists.

SVECH ME OUTSIDE

Andrei Svechnikov scored a goal and added an assist tonight to extend his goal/point streak to three games (10/26-11/1: 5g, 1a), which marks the longest goal streak of his NHL career. He has scored each of the Hurricanes' last four goals and five of the team's last six goals. Svechnikov is the first Hurricanes skater to score four consecutive team goals since Eric Staal, who accomplished the feat from 12/16/10-12/18/10.

SOMETHING'S FISHY

Sebastian Aho tallied three points (2g, 1a) tonight, marking the 13th three-point game of his career and first this season. He has now registered eight points in his last eight games (10/15-11/1: 4g, 4a) after posting one point in his first six games this season (10/3-10/12: 1g).

DOUG DYNASTY

Dougie Hamilton registered three assists tonight to extend his point streak to six games (10/16-11/1: 2g, 6a), which marks the longest point streak of his 518-game NHL career. He previously recorded five-game point streaks from 1/3/19-1/10/19 (3g, 3a) and from 1/6/18-1/14/18 (4g, 2a). Tonight marked the fifth three-assist game of his NHL career and first since 3/11/17 at WPG while playing for CGY.

GET SHORTY

Brock McGinn scored Carolina's second shorthanded goal of the season tonight. The goal marked the third shorthanded goal of McGinn's career and first since 1/6/19 at OTT. **Dougie Hamilton** picked up his second career shorthanded assist on the goal, with the other coming on 11/27/16 at PHI while playing for CGY.

MRAZZLE DAZZLE

Petr Mrazek made his sixth home start of the season tonight and won his 12th straight regular season home start at PNC Arena. In 2019-20, Mrazek has posted a 6-0-0 record, 1.97 goals-against average, .925 save percentage and one shutout on home ice. Including regular season and postseason, Mrazek owns a 26-5-1 career record at PNC Arena.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK

Carolina opened their fourth of 16 sets of back-to-back games this season. After tonight, the Hurricanes are 4-0-0 in the first game and 1-2-0 in the second game of back-to-backs in 2019-20.

BACK IN BLACK

The Hurricanes wore their black alternate uniforms for the second of 15 times this season. Carolina now holds a 2-0-0 record this season when wearing their third jerseys, after posting an 11-2-2 regular season record and 5-2 postseason record when wearing their black alternate uniforms last season.

IT TAKES TWO

Carolina scored seven goals tonight, marking the 13th straight game to open the season that the team has scored at least two goals. This is the third-longest season-opening streak of games with at least two goals scored in franchise history. Carolina last scored at least two goals in each of their first 13 games in 2005-06, when they accomplished the feat in each of their first 14 games, earning an 11-2-1 record in the process. The franchise record for consecutive games with at least two goals scored to open a season was set by the 1986-87 Whalers, who scored at least two goals in each of their first 15 games, posting a 7-5-3 record in those games.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 1-for-2 on the power play tonight and is now 10-for-41 (24.4%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes went 4-for-5 on the penalty kill and are now 41-for-50 (82.0%) on the kill this season.
- Detroit went 1-for-5 on the power play tonight and is now 7-for-47 (14.9%) on the man-advantage this season. The Red Wings went 1-for-2 on the penalty kill and are now 31-for-44 (70.5%) on the kill this season.
