HAULA HOLLA

Erik Haula tallied two points (1g, 1a) tonight, including his team-leading eighth goal of the season. Tonight's game marks the 29th multi-point game of his NHL career and his first with Carolina. Haula's last NHL multi-point game came against the Hurricanes on 11/3/18 while playing for VGK.

SOMETHING'S FISHY

Sebastian Aho recorded an assist tonight and has now registered nine points in his last eight games (10/15-11/2: 4g, 5a) after posting one point in his first six games this season (10/3-10/12: 1g).

SVECH ME OUTSIDE

Andrei Svechnikov tallied an assist tonight to extend his point streak to four games (10/26-11/2: 5g, 2a), tying his career-long point streak. He has previously recorded a point in four straight games twice in his NHL career, including earlier this season from 10/5-10/11 (1g, 7a). Svechnikov has now registered 15 points in 14 games this season (6g, 9a), after needing 30 games to reach 15 points last season.

TURBO TIME

Teuvo Teravainen scored a power-play goal tonight, marking the fourth consecutive game that the Hurricanes have scored a power-play goal. Including tonight, Carolina has now scored on five of their last 12 power plays (10/26-11/2: 41.7%). Teravainen leads the Hurricanes with seven power-play points this season (1g, 6a), while **Andrei Svechnikov** (2g, 4a) and **Dougie Hamilton** (1g, 5a) have each tallied six power-play points through 14 games.

IT TAKES TWO

Carolina scored three goals tonight, marking the 14th straight game to open the season that the team has scored at least two goals. This ties the second-longest season-opening streak of games with at least two goals scored in franchise history. Carolina last scored at least two goals in each of their first 14 games in 2005-06, earning an 11-2-1 record in the process. The franchise record for consecutive games with at least two goals scored to open a season was set by the 1986-87 Whalers, who scored at least two goals in each of their first 15 games, posting a 7-5-3 record in those games.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK

Carolina closed out their fourth of 16 sets of back-to-back games this season. After tonight, the Hurricanes are 4-0-0 in the first game and 1-3-0 in the second game of back-to-backs in 2019-20.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 1-for-4 on the power play today and is now 11-for-46 (23.9%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes went 3-for-4 on the penalty kill and are now 44-for-54 (81.5%) on the kill this season.
- New Jersey went 1-for-4 on the power play today and is now 7-for-47 (14.9%) on the man-advantage this season. The Devils went 3-for-4 on the penalty kill and are now 33-for-44 (75.0%) on the kill this season.
