-- Sebastian Aho earned his 11th career multi-point game (1g, 2a) and fourth career three-point night on Monday, including his first goal of the season (11/13/17 – 16th game). Aho scored his first goal of the season in game No. 14 last season (11/12/16) and finished his rookie campaign with 24 goals. The Rauma, Finland, native has recorded four points (2g, 2a) in four career games against the Stars and ranks third among Hurricanes skaters in multi-point games (11) since making his NHL debut last season.

-- Jordan Staal registered a career-high four assists against Dallas, marking the first four-assist game by a Hurricanes player since Eric Staal during the 2014-15 season (3/8/15 vs. EDM: 4a). In addition, Monday marked Staal's fifth career four-point game and his second four-point game of the season (10/17 at EDM: 1g, 3a). Since joining the team in 2012-13, Staal is ranked first on the team in four-point games (4) and his third assist on Monday marked his 200th Hurricanes point (73g, 128a).

-- Jeff Skinner scored his team-leading ninth goal of the season and is now four goals shy from passing Pat Verbeek (192) for seventh on Carolina's all-time goals list. Skinner's nine goals this season is the most goals he has earned through the first 16 games of a season in his career (2012-13: 7).

-- Trevor van Riemsdyk notched his second assist of the season and ranked second on the team in shots (5).

-- Elias Lindholm paced the Canes in faceoff win-percentage (63.0%), winning 5-of-8 faceoffs on Monday.

-- Josh Jooris led the team with five hits.

-- The Hurricanes earned their first win against Dallas at PNC Arena since April 3, 2014.

TURBO TIME

Teuvo Teravainen recorded his first career hat trick and added an assist against Dallas on Monday (3g, 1a). Teravainen became the first Hurricanes player to record a natural hat trick since Eric Staal (3g, 0a) in Carolina's 4-2 win over the Anaheim Ducks at PNC Arena on Dec. 18, 2010. Monday also marked Teravainen's second career four-point game (11/12/16 vs. WSH: 1g, 3a).

BETWEEN TWO FINNS

The Hurricanes top line of **Teuvo Teravainen** (3g, 1a), **Jordan Staal** (0g, 4a), and **Sebastian Aho** (1g, 2a) combined for 11 points in Carolina's 4-1 win over Dallas. Teravainen has registered 11 points in his last nine games (10/26-11/13: 4g, 7a), Staal has recorded eight points in his last seven games (10/29-11/13: 4g, 4a), and Aho has tallied seven points in his last seven games (10/29-11/13: 1g, 6a).

LEADING AMERICA

Since the start of the 2014-15 season, **Scott Darling** (.651) is ranked first in win-percentage among American-born goaltenders.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina was 1-for-4 on the power play tonight and is 7-for-53 (13.2%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes were 2-for-3 on the penalty kill and are 28-for-35 (80.0%) on the kill this season.
- Dallas was 1-for-3 on the power play tonight and is 16-for-51 (31.4%) on the man-advantage this season. The Stars were 3-for-4 on the penalty kill and are now 52-for-60 (86.7%) on the kill this season.
