- Jordan Martinook opened the scoring for the Hurricanes, and he is now tied with Andrei Svechnikov for third on the team in goals (8).
- Sebastian Aho tied his career single-game high with four points tonight (2g, 2a), marking his sixth multi-point game this season, the 31st multi-point game of his career, and the third four-point game of his career. Aho is now tied with Micheal Ferland for the team lead in goals (11).
- Teuvo Teravainen posted three points tonight (1g, 2a), marking his 32nd-career multi-point game (26th with Carolina) and ninth-career three-point game (eighth with Carolina).
- Andrei Svechnikov tallied an assist tonight, and now ranks tied for fourth among NHL rookies in points with 16 (8g, 8a).
- Justin Williams scored a goal tonight and has now scored six goals in his last 12 games after scoring one goal in his first 19 games this season.

FREE WILLY

Justin Williams' third-period goal was the 104th Hurricanes goal of his career. Williams has now recorded more goals, assists (166) and points (270) with Carolina than with any other team he has played for in his career.

POWERING UP

Sebastian Aho registered two power-play points tonight (1g, 1a), and he has factored into the scoring on 10 of Carolina's 19 power play goals this season (2g, 8a). The Hurricanes scored three power-play goals for the first time since going 3-for-5 in a 7-3 win vs. LAK (2/13/18).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING

With two goals and two assists tonight, **Sebastian Aho** has now recorded points in four consecutive games (12/7-12/14: 4g, 6a). It's his third point streak of four games or longer this season and the eighth of at least that length in his career. **Justin Williams** recorded a goal to extend his point streak to four games (3g, 1a)

QUICK ON THE DRAW

The Hurricanes won 35 of 60 faceoffs tonight, led by **Lucas Wallmark**, who won 17 of his 25 draws.

DARLING RETURNS

Scott Darling made his first appearance in net for Carolina since 11/24 at NYI. While on his latest assignment with the Checkers (11/30-12/9), Darling appeared in four games, posting a 2-1-0 record with a 2.72 GAA and .897 save percentage.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 3-for-6 on the power play tonight and is now 19-for-107 (17.8%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes went 1-for-2 on the penalty kill and are now 79-for-98 (80.6%) on the kill this season.
- Washington went 1-for-2 on the power play tonight and is now 26-for-95 (27.4%) on the man-advantage this season. The Capitals went 3-for-6 on the penalty kill and are now 87-for-114 (76.3%) on the kill this season.
